Looking back: Key achievements in 2016/17

- ♦ Induction for new VOCypf Officer, including visits to local voluntary and community groups and meetings with key local authority professionals.
- Contributed to key meetings and events in both LAs including: Safeguarding Children Board's and sub-groups; Acting Early, Children's Trust Board, Support and Aspiration Board - for Central Bedfordshire; Child Health and Well-Being Board, Domestic Abuse Delivery Group - for Bedford Borough.
- Reviewed VOCypf's communications as a result of a communications survey, and implemented improvements including:
 - the redesign and updating of VOCypf web pages;
 - ♦ the creation and promotion of a new VOCypf Bedfordshire Facebook Group;
 - ♦ distribution of VOCypf's re-designed, fortnightly newsletter.
- Undertook a training needs survey within the VOCypf network to inform use of the VOCypf Workforce Development Fund.
- ♦ Actively engaged with both LAs on safeguarding and quality standards and accreditation for voluntary and community groups.
- ♦ Actively engaged with both LAs to provide a VOCypf perspective on each agenda affecting children, young people and families.

Looking forward: Priorities for VOCypf 2017/18

- ♦ Continue to offer our two local authorities a voluntary sector perspective and look for opportunities for VOCypf to contribute through consultation and service delivery.
- Provide regular newsletter updates to keep the sector informed of national and local news, local events and training opportunities with a particular focus on safeguarding training.
- Launch and promote VOCypf's Bursary Fund for training which aims to help voluntary organisations in Bedford Borough and Central Bedfordshire to access training for staff and volunteers.
- Continue to use social media to increase communication with the sector and encourage a more interactive approach to communication between VOCypf and VCS organisations.
- ♦ Undertake a new safeguarding project for Bedford Borough Safeguarding Children Board.
- Seek to bring child poverty back onto the LAs' agendas.
